Montana Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB)

Federal Test Fee Reduction Program – School Year 2014-2015

Advanced Placement: Pending the availability of federal funding, the state of Montana will pay \$41 per AP Exam for public and private school students qualifying for the \$29 per exam College Board fee reduction.

- Final AP Exam fee for qualifying students: **\$12**

What the school must do:

Before the exams: On the AP Exam ordering website, enter the total number of students who your school can attest fulfill the federal criteria to receive fee reductions for low-income students and the total number of exams they will take.

After the exams:

- Fill in the "Option 1" circle on qualifying students' AP Exam answer sheets.
- When generating your invoice online, enter the total number of exams taken by qualifying students.
- AP coordinators must send \$12 to the AP program for each exam taken by qualifying students.
- The College Board will bill the state directly for \$41 per exam per qualifying student.
- AP coordinators must submit a copy of their invoice to the state.

International Baccalaureate: Pending the availability of federal funding, the state of Montana will pay \$98 per Exam for public and private school students qualifying for the fee reduction.
