For Site Administrators and Administrative Teams

Designed for site administrators and administrative teams, this professional development session identifies school leaders' Six Areas of Influence, which connect instructional leadership, evidence-based feedback and evaluation, and organizational structures and policies. Participants learn strategies for promoting collaborative relationships between site leaders, mentors/coaches, and teachers; and to effectively communicate and implement organizational structures and policies that enhance teacher development.

The Role of School Leaders in New Teacher Success provides school leaders with a high-level understanding of how

mentors assess and coach new teachers using NTC's research-based Formative Assessment and Support (FAS) system of tools and protocols.

Participants will:

- Articulate the school leader's essential role in supporting effective teaching and mentoring practice
- Use a conceptual framework to identify the school leader's areas of influence and to identify strategies that build and sustain a quality induction experience
- Assess current site-based practices related to high-quality induction
- Develop guidelines for mentor/school leader relationships and communications
- Use the Six Areas of Influence to advance school-wide goals and strengthen professional norms
