Definitions

ELL Identification	Test scores support decisions about whether a student may be an ELL and would benefit from English language support services or not.
ELL Placement	Test scores support decisions about relative strengths and weaknesses in different language domains (listening, reading, speaking, writing), showing the profile of a student's scores in the four domains. Abilities in the different domains may be meaningfully compared, helping inform instructional decisions.
ELL Progress	Test scores support decisions about the improvement made by a student in her/his language proficiency over a period of time. Domain scale scores (listening, reading, speaking, writing) may be used as an indication of progress or growth (improvement) in a particular language domain over a period of time.
Scale Score	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raw score (number of questions the child got right) adjusted for item difficulty • Range of possible scores is 100–600 (100–400 for Kindergarten) • Can be compared across periods of time, between students, and across grades • Cannot be compared across domains, as each domain has a separate scale
Domain Score	4 language domain scores: Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing
Composite Score	<p>Derived from domain scores</p> <p>4 Composite Score Types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overall Composite Score <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Includes Listening (15%), Speaking (15%), Reading (35%), Writing (35%) • Oral Language Composite Score <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Includes Listening (50%) and Speaking (50%) • Literacy Composite Score <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Includes Reading (50%) and Writing (50%) • Comprehension Composite Score <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Includes Listening (30%) and Reading (70%)
Proficiency Level Score	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes student performance in terms of the 6 WIDA ELP levels • Is derived from the scale score (note that the interpretation of scale scores to proficiency level is grade specific, so the same scale score will translate to a different proficiency level score if the grade level is different) • At the domain level, proficiency scores can be used with the WIDA Can Do Descriptors to get a profile of the student's English language performance • Informs targeted language instruction using the WIDA ELD Standards • Provides information to help determine program eligibility
