What to expect during your Work Session:

Help with every aspect of TEAMS, from uploading, hand-entering, or rolling over TOE and Teacher-Class records to running the Preliminary Accreditation Report and understanding any generated deviations.

This is not a training. The facilitators are there to help you work with your own data, and will walk the entire group through the process, step-by-step. There may be up to 20 people attending each session, so patience and a willingness to refer to the manual during busy times is encouraged and appreciated.

Each participant is expected to work through the system at their own pace. If your TOE information is not completely entered into TEAMS, you may start with this step, but you may not be able to submit your data by the end of the day.

DON'T FORGET:

Bring all information needed to complete the entry process in order to make the most of your session. Remember the order of data entry; if this order is not followed, information can be lost:
